

HIROSHIMA IS STILL BURNING

To remember the 6th of August is more important than ever. It is the memorial day of more than 200.000 victims of the nuclear bombs, which were thrown at the two Japanese towns Hiroshima and Nagasaki in 1945. The issue of nuclear weapons is, at these times, a very serious issue within the international, political scene. After the war began in Ukraine in 2022, as well as after the escalation of the armament agenda of the U.S. and NATO, the risks of nuclear war has become bigger. And Denmark is no exception. Hiding behind the lies about that "more weaponry ensures peace and freedom", Denmark plays its part in the armament race. In the government's recent defence settlement, there has been nothing less than an extra 143 billion kr been set aside for the next 10 years of war preparations. This is tax money which is financed from welfare cuttings and increasing working hours (Store Bededag). The Danish politicians are not doing anything to ensure peace, as they are part of the imperialistic order, which is very cause of the wars. What they give us is increased insecurity and threats resulting from warfare.

We demand that the Danish government stops the rearming spiral and the war preparations, and starts to invest in the public welfare, wages and working conditions. We will not pay the imperialist wars!
